

November Council Meeting Highlights: Youth: There are few attending events and the call is for all of us to encourage the youth to remain active and participate. 

Pastor Barlau has been researching moving options and companies to move his family to Abilene. The most probable option will bring the household goods the first week on January 2021. Church members will be called upon to help unload and settle the family into the rental house upon their arrival. 

The \$5,000 gift from an Indiana parishioner at Pastor Barlau's current church will be used toward the moving expenses. 

Zach Krause is making arrangements for replacing the HVAC system in the rental house. 

The church Operating Manual section on Chair of Board of Education is currently being reviewed and modified. 

Church & rental house hail damage will be repaired/replaced when the contractor is available and the weather permits. 

A three month contract will be made with the Roll-n-Smoke barbeque wagon owner to park occasionally in the east parking lot.

#### FAITH LUTHERAN ABILENE WAS ORGANIZED AS A CONGREGATION ON OCTOBER 31, 1950

The first minister, Reverend Harold Kamman, was ordained and installed at Faith on August 20, 1950. He served as our pastor until November 24, 1957. Some of you may remember him from that time, or at least from

Faith's 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration in 2010. In the picture at the right, he is at the upper left of the group of our past ministers. When he left Faith, he got married



and began serving in Oklahoma for many years. We have received information and a call to consider helping to support the Rev. Harold Kamman Chapel Expansion Fund in Oklahoma City. This Concordia Community Foundation supports the Concordia Life Plan Community to advance their ministry to the aging.
