#### Dear Friends,

Sunday, June 9 will celebrate the Day of Pentecost—the 50<sup>th</sup> day after Easter. Pentecost is equally important to the Christian Church as both Christmas and Easter! Yes, we believe that if Jesus had not been born, He would not have been able to rescue us. Yes, we believe that if Jesus did not die on a Cross and bodily rise from the dead, then would not have the forgiveness of our sins and the gift of eternal life.

But the day of Pentecost stands with Christmas and Easter as equally important. Why? Because, beginning with Pentecost, the Holy Spirit fills believers and spreads the Gospel! 
