#### "Change??? Lutherans' Don't Change!"

Covid-19 has caused many churches to swallow those words for the sake caring for our neighbor—the Common Cup was tabled, the water fountain sealed off, coffee and fellowship sidelined, etc.

We are thankful that it looks like we are "on the horizon" of relief from the pandemic! Over the following months at Faith, you may have noticed or will notice some things come back (some with adjustments) to our life together in worship and fellowship.

The Common Cup will be an option again to receive the Blood of Christ. It has always been a safe option—Churches during the time of the Bubonic Plague continued to use the Common Cup with not one breakout or illness stemming back to its use. There have been many scientific studies on the common cup that prove it being a safe way to receive the Sacrament. We will be using a small cloth soaked high proof alcohol to wipe the cup after each use. If you would like to receive the Common Cup in lieu of the individual cup please indicate to Pastor Barlau when He comes with the Cup after you have received the Body of Christ that you would like to partake.

Coffee and the water fountain are again an option that is available. Coffee right now is being served to you rather than self-serve in the past. The Board Evangelism welcomes your help in serving coffee after service, please contact the Church Office to sign-up for a Sunday.

As we move forward with bringing back or adapting practices at Faith, know that these decisions are made with care and thoughtful deliberation. I and the Church council covet your prayers, patience, grace, and words.




