John 10:14, Jesus says, "I am the Good Shepherd."

Dear Friends,

I want you to remember this—Jesus is the only person who could die for your sins on the Cross and bodily rise from the dead on Easter morning. Jesus did this so that your sins might be forgiven and that you might now be His dear child, an heir of life eternal.

There is <u>absolutely nothing</u> that we could do on our own to save ourselves and "to get right with God" as some churches or religions teach. We can't pray to Mary or knock on enough people's doors or go on a 2-year mission journey or even put enough money into the offering plate to somehow buy our way into heaven. Salvation is found in Christ alone. By His life, suffering, death and resurrection, Jesus has proven that He is God's Son—the great I AM.

In Psalm 23, David describes Jesus as the Good Shepherd. By faith, He has included us to be part of His flock, leading us to green pastures and still waters. He guides us down the paths of righteousness, even in the midst of death, with the rod and staff of His Word. He gives Himself to us in such a way that our cups are not just full, but they are overflowing. He promises that we will dwell in His house forever.

By faith, we are a part of Christ's flock. Jesus tells His flock that He will lay down His own life for us upon Calvary's Cross.

It's not so much that we know Him, but it's that He knows us. He calls us by name. He gives us the faith to confess His Name. Where? In Holy Baptism, He has covered us with His blood. We now wear the white robe of righteousness. We are granted faith, forgiven of our sins, and made to be His sons and daughters—now and forever.

You must keep hearing the voice of the Shepherd to be strengthened and grow in the Christian faith. Think about this—to cut yourself off from the flock is to cut yourself off from the Shepherd. You must continue to worship here at church to hear and study His Word. You must hear that voice at home. Take time to daily read the Bible. Spend a few minutes with the Lord by using a devotion.



You must be fed by the Shepherd at His Table. When you eat and drink His true body and blood in the unleavened bread and wine of His Supper, Jesus says that He is living in you to forgive your sins and strengthen your faith. Think about this—If Jesus is living in you, it makes the attack of Satan that much harder on you.

Jesus also says of Himself in John 6:35 concerning His Supper,

"I am the bread of life; whoever comes to Me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in Me shall never thirst." Come and receive often what the Lord wants to give to you at His Table. He feeds and cares for you now and forever. He cannot lie. He cannot deceive. His word is always true!

You see, that's the kind of Shepherd we <u>all</u> need. The Shepherd who stays with His flock—feeding, protecting, caring, and nurturing you throughout all of your earthly days until He calls you to be with Himself on the Last Day. ~ *Pastor Panzer*






